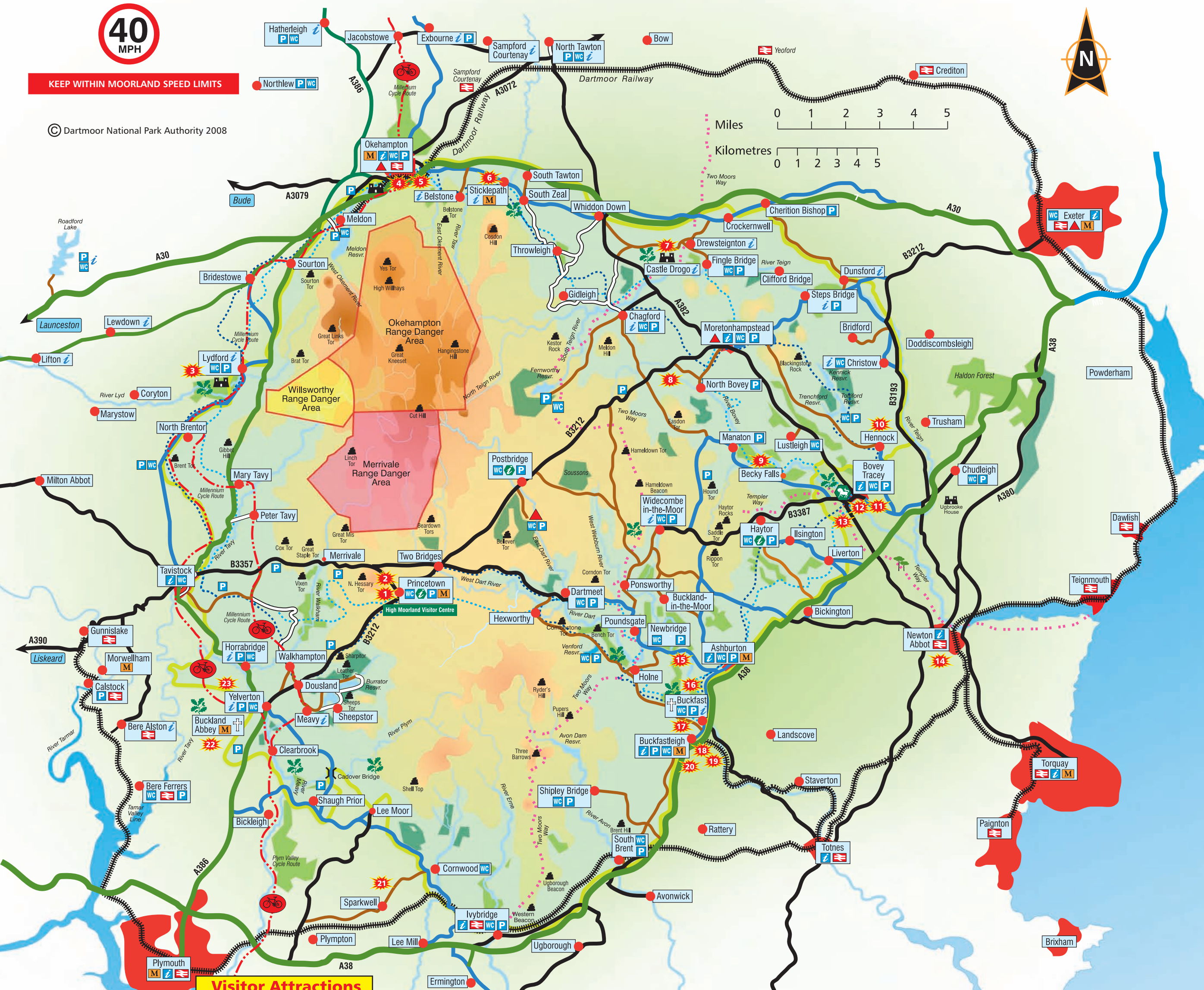
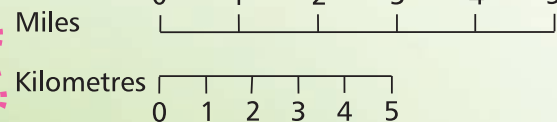




KEEP WITHIN MOORLAND SPEED LIMITS

WHICH ROADS TO USE ON DARTMOOR - Drive with moor care

Green Routes
Green routes are suitable for all vehicles and are national through routes.

Black Routes
Black routes are A or B class roads - suitable for most types of traffic.

Blue Routes
Blue routes are suitable for medium sized vehicles.

Brown Routes
Brown routes are only suitable for cars and other small vehicles.

FINGER POSTS
Traditional finger signposts show roads that should only be used to local destinations.

Unsigned roads are only suitable for local access traffic.
