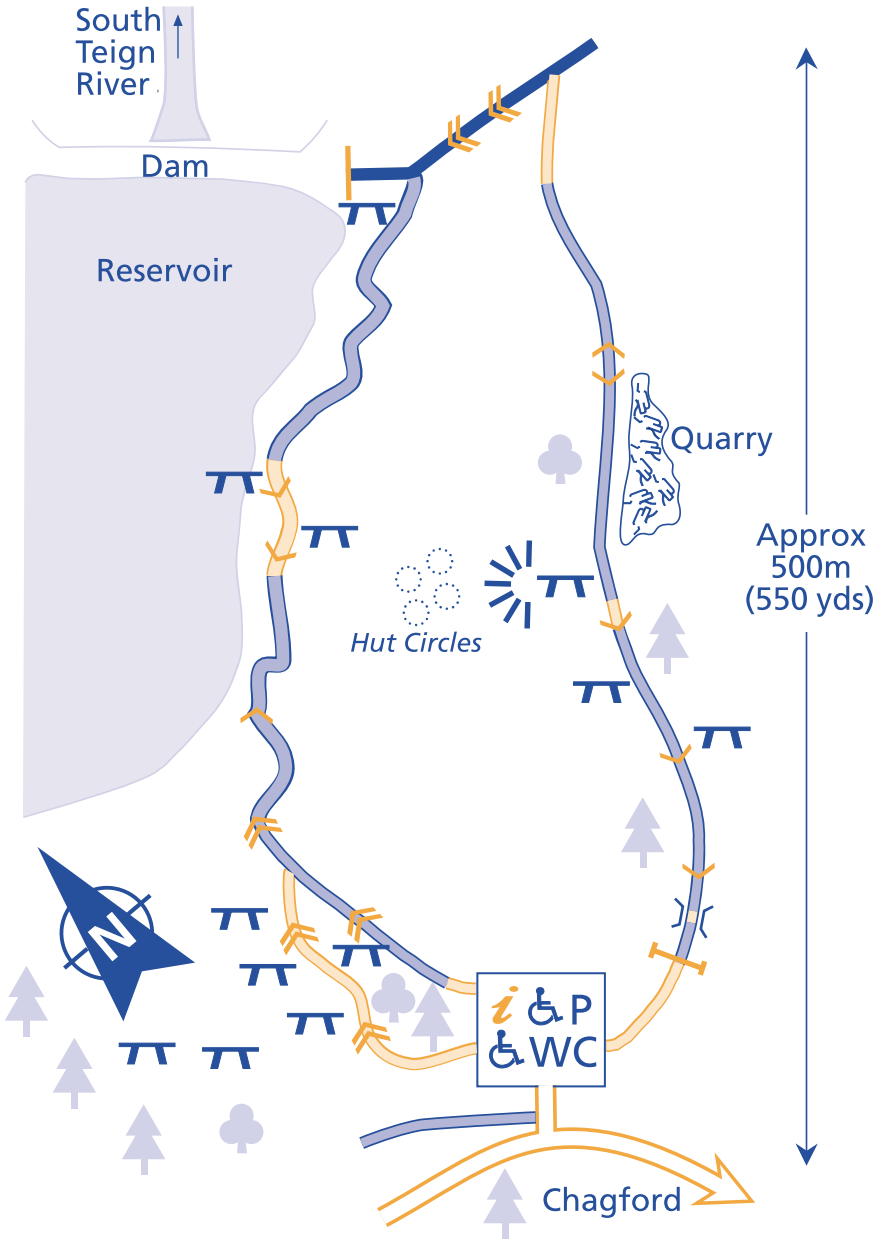
Fernworthy Reservoir, a site managed by South West Lakes Trust, is surrounded by forest and open moorland, and is a beautiful area in which to spend free time. From the main car park, a purpose built path has been constructed following the route of Potter's Walk. From here you will enjoy good views over prehistoric hut circles, the magnificent dam and the reservoir itself. Benches, resting posts and perches are provided at regular intervals for those who wish to stop and enjoy the view. There is also a picnic area overlooking the reservoir.

If you drive beyond the main car park, you will come to a grassy area used for parking. From here you can access a bird hide which is suitable for wheelchairs and built to standards set by the Royal Society for the Protection of Birds. The hide provides great views over a protected area of the reservoir.

The reservoir is signposted from Chagford.
