This walk follows a section of the disused Princetown to Plymouth Railway. It passes through a mixture of broadleaved and coniferous woodland owned by South West Water before emerging onto the edge of Yennadon Down. Although this is a linear route with a steady descent there are stunningly different views in each direction. Once you are in the open heading south you will have great views of Burrator Dam and across the reservoir to Sheeps Tor. Looking north on the return journey, Burrator Reservoir will be laid out before you with Leather Tor and Sharpitor rising up behind.

There is limited parking in a small car park close to the route. There is also a drop off point at the start of the route itself. Please do not park alongside the route or in the loading bay opposite as this is a working forest and at times this area is used for stacking and loading timber.
