## The Viaduct (Tavistock)

Following the disused Tavistock to Plymouth railway line across the viaduct, the path continues approximately 1 mile (1.6km) through the railway cutting, which in itself is a valuable wildlife sanctuary and designated Local Nature Reserve with water, wetland and grassland habitats. Picnic tables are located at the far end of the path. From here there are views over the town to the moors.

Park at the West Devon Borough Council Offices at Kilworthy Park on Drake Road. Dedicated spaces are available close to the access path to the viaduct.
