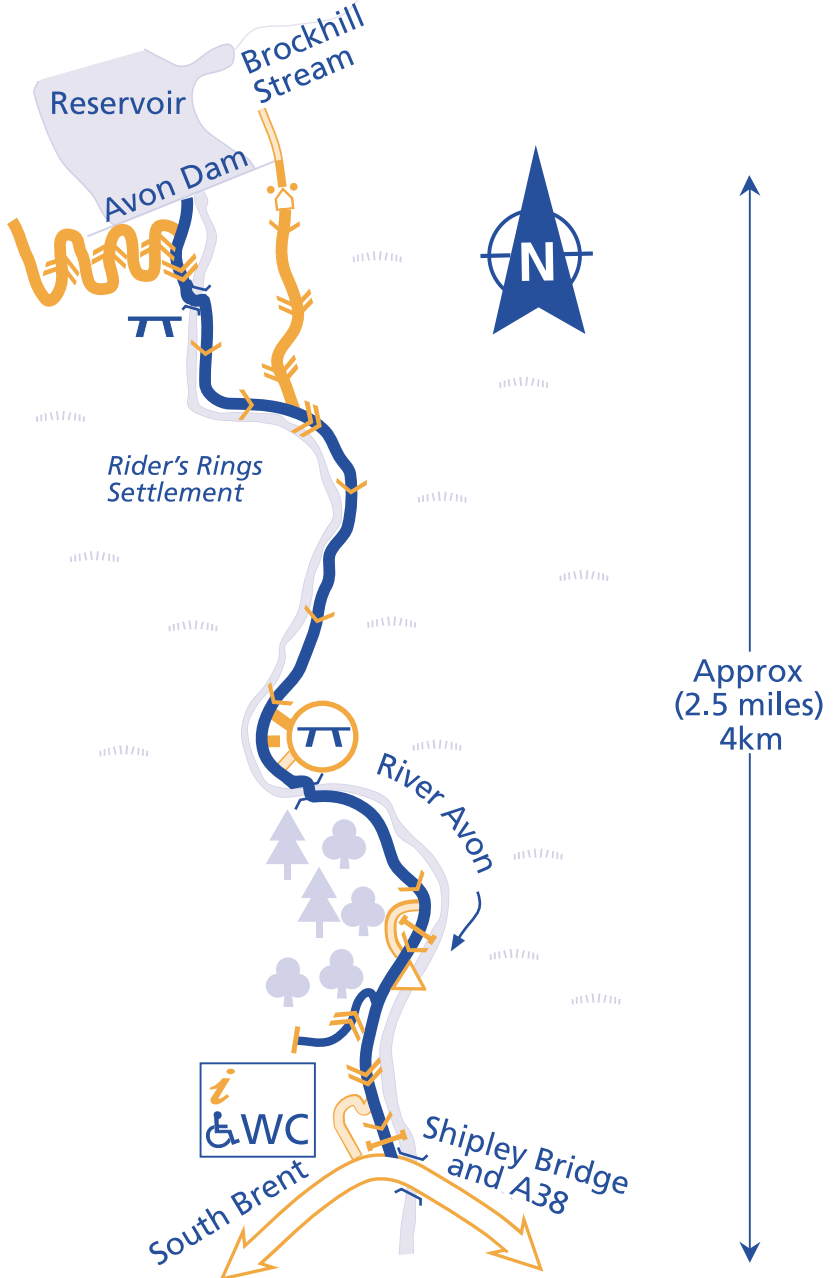
Please note that this moorland route traverses exposed country.

A beautiful walk, of up to 2<sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub> miles (4km). The surfaced road, which is not open to vehicles, follows the Avon River from Shiptley Bridge to the foot of the dramatic Avon Dam. The landscape is varied, from gentle riverside to views over open moorland. Please note that the route to the Avon Dam is a steady and continuous climb.

Car parking is at Shiptley Bridge. Please note that the car park can be very busy at peak times.
