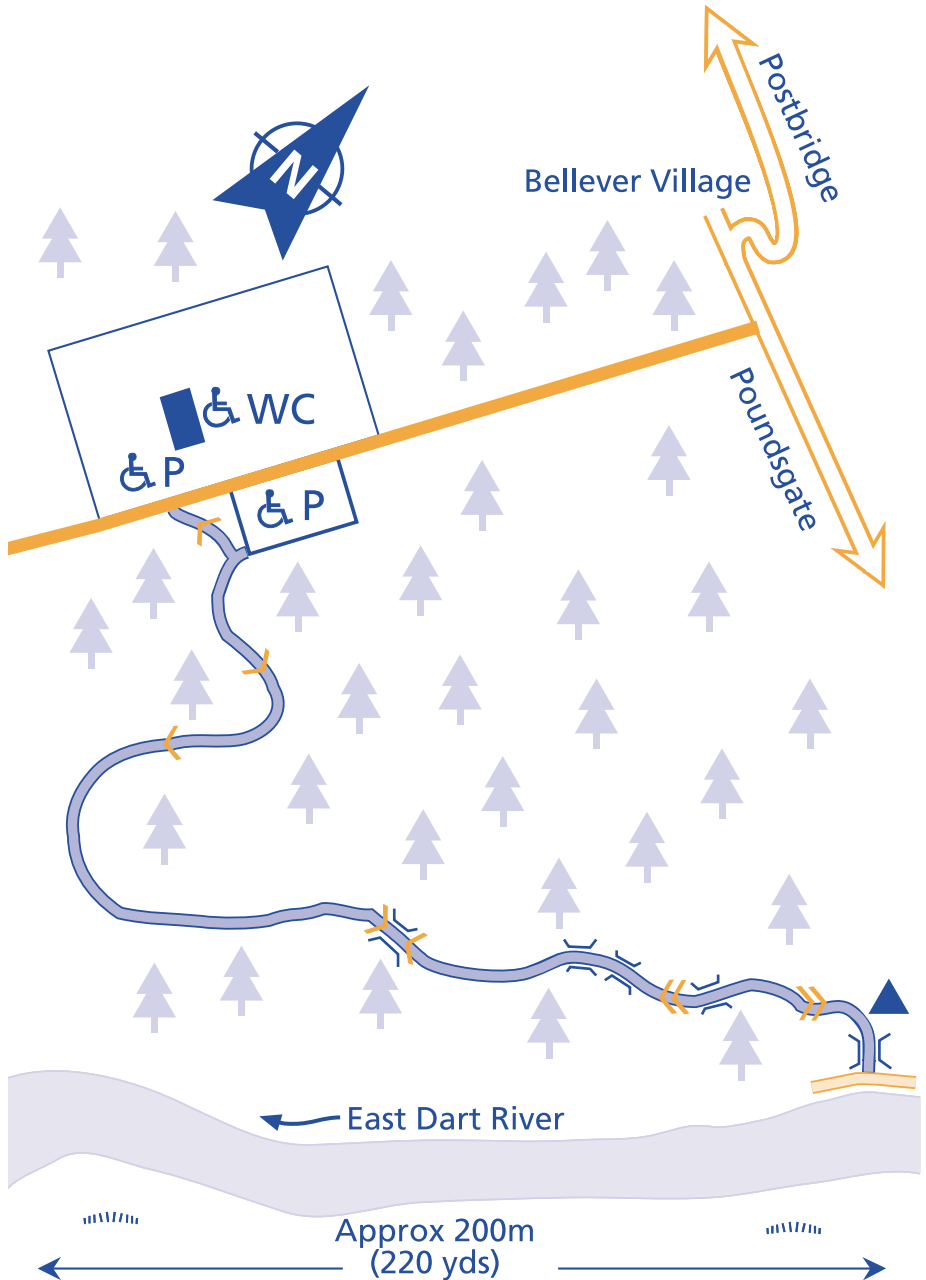
Enjoy both woodland and riverside in this area which is managed by Forest Enterprise. This high Dartmoor forest was planted in 1921 by the Duchy of Cornwall, primarily to replenish national timber resources. The forest extends just below Bellever and Laughter Tors. Crossbills, buzzards and ravens can often be seen and you may see a dipper bobbing along the East Dart River.

A short length of path meanders through the shady forest to link the car park with the East Dart River. It then continues along the riverbank, providing ideal picnic spots.

Bellever Forest main car park is located about 1 mile (1.6km) from Postbridge.
