Please note that this moorland route traverses exposed country.

Situated approximately $\frac{3}{4}$ mile (1km) west of Two Bridges off the B3357 this route follows an unsurfaced track north, into open country, and provides a sense of remoteness, even though you are never far from the car park. On a clear day there are wonderful views across the Cowsic valley towards Beardown Tors.

Please note that part of this route is within the Merrivale Training Area. Before entering this area you must check whether firing is scheduled. Information on firing times is available from local newspapers, at Dartmoor National Park Information Centres or by telephoning 0800 4584868. When firing is taking place on the ranges, warning signals (red flags by day and lights by night) are displayed on prominent tors. It is then dangerous to cross the line of red and white poles which mark the range boundary.
