CORE STRATEGY DEVELOPMENT PLAN DOCUMENT - SUBMISSION VERSION

The Dartmoor National Park Authority has submitted the *Core Strategy Development Plan Document* to the Secretary of State. The Core Strategy is part of the Dartmoor National Park Local Development Framework. It sets a vision and provides an overall strategy and spatial policies for sustainable development within the Dartmoor National Park in the period up to 2026. The Authority invites formal representations on the document. All duly made representations will be considered at an independent examination to be conducted by an inspector appointed by the Planning Inspectorate. The Core Strategy and supporting documentation is accessible on the Authority's website: www.dartmoor-npa.gov.uk Paper copies are available on request.

A request may be made to be notified of the publication of the Inspector's Report on the independent examination and the adoption of the Core Strategy Development Plan Document by the Dartmoor National Park Authority.
