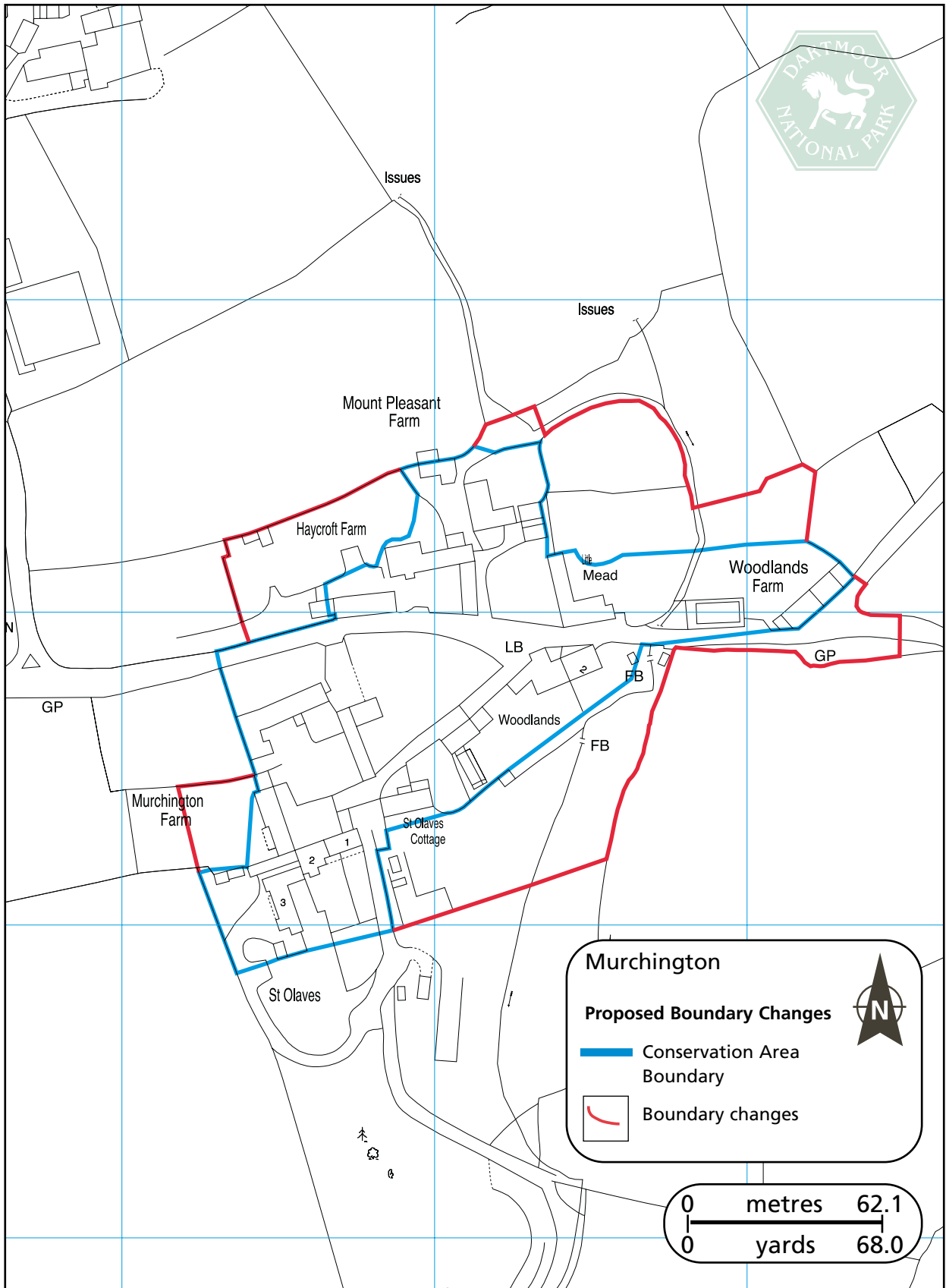


10. Proposed Boundary Changes

The Conservation Area boundary was originally drawn in 1975 to include all the historic buildings in the settlement. For much of its length, however, it did not follow property boundaries but crossed garden areas and other spaces in a somewhat arbitrary manner, creating an unclear picture of precisely what parts were included. In addition, some of the property boundaries that were followed in 1975 have since disappeared. It is recommended, therefore, that the boundary of the Conservation Area be re-drawn so that it has a much clearer relationship with current property boundaries and takes account also of the revisions made in the up-dated versions of the Ordnance Survey Maps. The buildings included will remain the same but the settings they occupy will be more clearly defined. Refer Map 9 page 30.
